

Guidelines for Lake Mills Farmers' Market



The Lake Mills Main Street Program welcomes you!

Wednesday evening Farmers' Market starts on May 6 and runs through October 28. Hours are from 2 PM until dusk.

Set-up time is 1 hour prior to when the market starts.

Booth spaces are on a first come first serve basis.

All Vendors must fill out a Farmers Market Registration each year and records will kept on file at the Main Street office.

All merchandise and vendors must follow all the City of Lake Mills Ordinance Rules. A copy of the Public Market Ordinance can be found at <http://www.ci.lake-mills.wi.us/Ordinances/Ord-983.htm> or call the Main Street office at 920-648-2344.

No vehicles can be driven into the park without special permission from the City.

No items may be sold from any vehicle. Once your goods have been unloaded from your vehicle, **your vehicle must be moved** to one of the city's parking lots behind Greenwoods State Bank or west of Sentry in the Municipal Building parking lot on Water Street.

The following homegrown or handmade items are welcome: landscaping plants, fresh produce, hand crafted items, fine arts, baked goods, meat products and eggs (food items must have appropriate licenses). Rummage items are NOT allowed.

If you sell baked goods, eggs or meat you must show proof of permits required by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture to the Market Representative and display permits at booth. Contact Marty Kehrein, Food Safety Inspector, at 608-222-6354 for additional information.

The following items are NOT welcome: live animals, tobacco products, liquor, or fermented malt beverages, drugs, drug paraphernalia, medical supplies or equipment, medications, firearms, ammunition, fireworks, or explosive devices.

Per city ordinance items in glass containers may NOT be consumed in the park.
